IIT Roorkee has introduced seven new academic programmes. The courses will be offered to students from the session 2021-2022. It has added six postgraduate degree programmes and one five-year integrated programme into its curriculum. The seven new programmes include M.Tech. (Artificial Intelligence), M.Tech. (Data Science) under the Centre for Artificial Intelligence and Data Science (CAIDS), M. Des. (Industrial Design), and MIM (Masters in Innovation Management) under the Department of Design, Online M. Tech. (Microelectronics and VLSI) for working industry professionals under the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, MS Economics (Five-Year Integrated programme) under the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, and M.Tech. (Dam Safety and Rehabilitation) under the proposed 'International Centre for Dams' (currently coordinated by Department of Hydrology). "All the new academic programmes initiated address the needs of our country. To offer these programs, IIT Roorkee has

established one new department of Design and one new centre for Artificial Intelligence and Data Science

• IIT Roorkee launches an Earthquake Early Warning Mobile App

The mobile application is available in two versions, compatible with both Android and iOS platforms. The project was sponsored by Uttarakhand State Disaster Management Authority (USDMA), since the Uttarakhand region is most seismically active and prone to earthquakes. The Chief Minister of Uttarakhand Sri Pushkar Singh Dhami launched this life guarding app on August 4, 2021, at 11 am. It is a path-breaking achievement for the institute as it is the country's first application for notifying people about earthquake alerts. The programme was initially launched as a pilot project only by the Ministry of Earth Sciences, Govt. of India for the Garhwal region of Uttarakhand. Given its success and the need of the region, IIT Roorkee's EEW project proposal was further extended by the Uttarakhand Government.

IIT Roorkee professors featured in 50 Inspirational Women in STEM Education by CII

The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Roorkee, celebrated its women professors, who have contributed phenomenally with their research in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) subjects. Their active participation in the field has proven exemplary in promoting and transforming women's role in STEM subjects. It is a matter of great pride for the institution that four of its professors have featured in the compendium by the Confederation of Indian Industry - CII on women achievers from India in STEM. The IIT Roorkee professors, part of the compendium is Prof Davinder Kaur Walia, Department of Physics and Centre for Nanotechnology; Prof Debrupa Lahiri, Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering and Center for Nanotechnology, Prof Pranita P. Sarangi, Department of Biological Sciences and Bioengineering and Prof Kusum Deep, Department of Mathematics and Centre for Artificial Intelligence and Data Science, at IIT Roorkee. They are also actively involved in designing various programmes specifically engineered to encourage and bring forth women of great calibre and true potential. • James Thomason Scholarship for Top JEE (Advanced) Rankers at IIT Roorkee

Students having up to 250 All India Rank in JEE (Advanced) 2021 are eligible for the James Thomason Scholarship. All such students admitted to IIT Roorkee will get Rs 25000/- per month for the entire duration of their program. They will be expected to obtain a CGPA of 8.0, or above, at the end of every academic year.

- Indian Institute of Technology Roorkee has secured 1st Rank in the National Institute Ranking Framework, (NIRF) India Rankings 2021 for the Architecture category. The Department of Architecture and Planning at IIT Roorkee currently offers Bachelor in Architecture, Masters in Architecture, and Masters in Urban and Rural Planning courses.
- Indian Institute of Technology Roorkee is collaborating with the Mehta Family Foundation (MFF), USA, to establish the Mehta Family School of Data Science and Artificial Intelligence. The two organisations have signed a MoU during a virtual

event on 27th September 2021. Under this collaboration, the new institute will offer Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral degree programs. It will welcome its first cohort of Bachelor's degree students in September 2022. The institute aims to develop new and skilled manpower in the areas of data science and artificial intelligence along with an objective to empower existing manpower by offering focused training and certifications in these fields.

Atomic Research Centre and has played a major role in India's dynamic Nuclear Power Program As Head of the Nuclear Fuel Complex, he has contributed significantly to the first stage of the Indian Nuclear Power Program by achieving the highest production of nuclear fuel and other strategic structural materials. Dr. Srivastava has

been conferred with various awards and recognitions including the National Metallurgist Award, the highly coveted HomiBhabha Science & Technology Award, Vasvik Award for Materials Science & Engineering and many more.

Dr. SSV Ramakumar (1984 - M.Sc. - Chemistry & 1988 - Ph.D. - Chemistry) - Dr. SSV Ramakumar Director, R&D and Board member of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., has more than three decades of uninterrupted



experience in downstream hydrocarbons sector, notably in the areas of lubricant technology; refinery process research and catalyst development. He is instrumental in the development of India's homegrown,OEM-approved marine lubricant technology. Dr. Ramakumar also steers the Indian Oil start-up initiatives and has successfully incubated more than 30 start-up ideas so far.
